

GUIDELINES FOR SOLO SHOWS U.U.C.S. LEXOW GALLERY

Original artworks in all media are welcome, including those that are not for sale. All artwork should not have been shown at UUCS previously.

Original prints (produced manually by the artist), digital ink-jet printer reproductions using pigment inks on archival substrates (giclées), as well as photography prints can be exhibited. Other prints can only be displayed unframed in a print rack during the opening reception.

All prints should be numbered as an edition. With the exception of original prints and photography, no more than 25% of the pieces in a show should be prints.

Collages should not include whole, unaltered images unless permission from the original artist is obtained.

All wall pieces should be ready to hang. Frames should be in good condition and, if applicable, glazed with either plexiglas or regular glass.

Unframed canvasses should be gallery-wrapped and painted on all sides.

Three-dimensional art can be exhibited in the covered pedestals.

Four-6 weeks prior to your show opening, the Arts Council publicity chair should receive from you a short bio or artist statement or description of the focus of your show, along with 2-3 high resolution jpegs of your work and yourself.

An artist may have another solo show after 2 years.
